### Special Offering



***We Worship with Confession.***

Pastor: Remembering our baptism into Christ Jesus, we gather as we are to live in the name of the Father, and of the (†) Son, and of the Holy Spirit. **Congregation: Amen.**

P: Beloved in the LORD, let us draw near with faithful hearts and confess our sins to God our Father, asking Him, in the name of our LORD Jesus Christ to grant us forgiveness.

P: Our help is in the name of the LORD. **C: Who made heaven and earth.**

P: I said, I will confess my sins unto the LORD. **C: May God forgive the offense of my sin.**

P: (facing altar which symbolizes God's presence): *Almighty God, our Maker and Redeemer, C: we confess to You that we are by nature sinners and that we have sinned against You by thought, word and deed, by what we have done and by what we have left undone. Therefore, we flee for refuge to Your infinite mercy, pleading for and seeking Your grace for the sake of our LORD Jesus Christ.*

(Silence for personal reflection and self-examination.)

P: *Most merciful God... C: You have given Your only begotten Son to die for us. Have mercy upon us, and for Jesus' sake grant us forgiveness of all our sins; and by Your Holy Spirit increase in us true knowledge of You and of Your will, and true obedience to Your Word, that by Your grace we may come to eternal life; through Jesus Christ our LORD. Amen.*

P: (facing the congregation declares God's grace): Almighty God, our heavenly Father, has had mercy upon us, and has given His only Son to die for us, and for Jesus' sake God forgives us all our sins. To those who believe on Jesus' Name, He gives power to become children of God and bestows on them His Holy Spirit. Those who believe and are baptized shall be saved. Grant this, O LORD, unto us all. **C: Amen.**

**All: Praise the LORD!**

We are sent to make disciples of all nations (Matt. 28:19). We begin by sharing the peace of the LORD with one another.

***Cantors sing verses 1-3, Congregation sings responsively the refrain.***

<sup>4</sup> John to the seven churches that are in Asia: Grace to you and peace, from Him who is and who was and who is to come, and from the seven Spirits who are before His throne, <sup>5</sup> and from Jesus Christ, the faithful witness, the firstborn of the dead, and the ruler of the kings of the earth. To Him who loves us and released us from our sins <sup>[b]</sup>by His blood— <sup>6</sup> and He has made us *to be* a kingdom, priests to His God and Father—to Him *be* the glory and the dominion forever and ever.

**The preaching text is from the Book of Nehemiah, the 2<sup>ND</sup> chapter (NASB)**

And it came about in the month Nisan, in the twentieth year of King Artaxerxes, that wine was before him, and I took up the wine and gave it to the king. Now I had not been sad in his presence. <sup>2</sup> So the king said to me, “Why is your face sad though you are not sick? This is nothing but sadness of heart.” Then I was very much afraid. <sup>3</sup> I said to the king, “Let the king live forever. Why should my face not be sad when the city, the place of my fathers’ tombs, lies desolate and its gates have been consumed by fire?” <sup>4</sup> Then the king said to me, “What would you request?” So, I prayed to the God of heaven. <sup>5</sup> I said to the king, “If it please the king, and if your servant has found favor before you, send me to Judah, to the city of my fathers’ tombs, that I may rebuild it.” <sup>6</sup> Then the king said to me, the queen sitting beside him, “How long will your journey be, and when will you return?” So, it pleased the king to send me, and I gave him a definite time. <sup>7</sup> And I said to the king, “If it please the king, let letters be given me for the governors *of the provinces* beyond the River, that they may allow me to pass through until I come to Judah, <sup>8</sup> and a letter to Asaph the keeper of the king’s forest, that he may give me timber to make beams for the gates of the fortress which is by the temple, for the wall of the city and for the house to which I will go.” And the king granted *them* to me because the good hand of my God was on me.

<sup>9</sup> Then I came to the governors *of the provinces* beyond the River and gave them the king’s

letters. Now the king had sent with me officers of the army and horsemen. <sup>10</sup> When Sanballat the Horonite and Tobiah the Ammonite <sup>[b]</sup>official heard *about it*, it was very displeasing to them that someone had come to seek the welfare of the sons of Israel.

<sup>11</sup> So I came to Jerusalem and was there three days. <sup>12</sup> And I arose in the night, I and a few men with me. I did not tell anyone what my God was putting into my <sup>[c]</sup>mind to do for Jerusalem and there was no animal with me except the animal on which I was riding. <sup>13</sup> So I went out at night by the Valley Gate in the direction of the Dragon’s Well and *on* to the Refuse Gate, inspecting the walls of Jerusalem which were broken down and its gates which were consumed by fire. <sup>14</sup> Then I passed on to the Fountain Gate and the King’s Pool, but there was no place for my mount to pass. <sup>15</sup> So I went up at night by the ravine and inspected the wall. Then I entered the Valley Gate again and returned. <sup>16</sup> The officials did not know where I had gone or what I had done; nor had I as yet told the Jews, the priests, the nobles, the officials or the rest who did the work.

<sup>17</sup> Then I said to them, “You see the bad situation we are in, that Jerusalem is desolate, and its gates burned by fire. Come, let us rebuild the wall of Jerusalem so that we will no longer be a reproach.” <sup>18</sup> I told them how the hand of my God had been favorable to me and also about the king’s words which he had spoken to me. Then they said, “Let us arise and build.” So, they put their hands to

the good work. <sup>19</sup> But when Sanballat the Horonite and Tobiah the Ammonite official, and Geshem the Arab heard it, they mocked us and despised us and said, "What is this thing you are doing? Are you rebelling against the king?" <sup>20</sup> So I answered them and said to them, "The God

of heaven will give us success; therefore, we His servants will arise and build, but you have no portion, right or memorial in Jerusalem."

(This is the Word of the LORD)

**Holy Communion:** Lutherans believe the LORD's Supper is a holy sacrament in which Christ comes to us with His grace, love, compassion, and forgiveness. The crucified and risen Christ is present in, with, and under the bread and wine – He promises: "This is my body... This is my blood". Therefore, the Apostle Paul says we should examine ourselves lest we eat or drink in an unworthy manner (1 Cor. 11:27ff.). Martin Luther wrote, "Anyone who does not believe these words ('this is My body given for you this is My blood shed for you. '), is neither prepared nor worthy; for the words, 'FOR YOU' requires simply a believing heart." Therefore, all (including children who have received instruction) who believe in Jesus Christ as Savior and LORD and who see His presence in the sacrament are welcome to commune with us.

As you come forward for communion, you are invited to dip your fingers in the water of the baptismal font and then make the sign of the cross on your forehead as a reminder of Christ's claim upon you through your baptism.  
(For those with gluten allergies, we now have gluten-free wafers available for Communion on the Baptismal Font.)
