We want your home-based worship to be as rich as possible, and offer these suggestions as you prepare:

- Make sure you know how to access our YouTube Channel beforehand. Whether the format for the service you are watching is live stream or prerecorded, the location is the same.

- Set a worshipful setting. Light a candle. Sit in silence. Pray. Listen to worshipful music.
- Look up the readings in your Bible ahead of time and bookmark the pages.
- Have bread and wine or grape juice available for Holy Communion on Sunday mornings.
